## **DIRECTIONS TO MARIE CALLENDER'S:**

Research Blvd is also the Hwy 183 access road. Mapquest or GPS directions may vary.

**From the north:** Go south on Mopac and exit at Braker Lane. Stay in the middle lane on the Mopac access road heading south. Cross Braker Lane and then Capital of Texas Highway (Loop 360). Move to the right lane and follow the turn around to the right into the Hwy 183 northbound access road (Research Blvd.). Turn right into the Gateway Center just after Stonelake Blvd. Marie Callender's is on the right.

**From the south:** Go north on Mopac and exit at Capital of Texas 360/Braker Lane right after going under the Hwy 183 ramp. Turn left onto 360 and immediately turn left onto the southbound Mopac access road. Move to the right lane and follow the access road turn around to the right and onto the Hwy 183 northbound access road (Research Blvd.). Turn right into the Gateway Center just after Stonelake Blvd. Marie Callender's is on the right.

**From the east:** Go west on Hwy 183. Exit at Capital of Texas/360 (Research Blvd.). Move to the right lane and turn right into the Gateway Center just after Stonelake Blvd. Marie Callender's is on the right.

**From the west:** Go south on Hwy 183 and exit at Capital of Texas/360 Cross 360 and continue south to the North Hwy 183 U turn (on the left). Follow the U turn around, then head north in the right lane of the Hwy 183 access road. Turn right into to the Gateway Shopping Center just after Stonelake Blvd. Marie Callender's is on the right.
